This sample program suggests one way to navigate the curriculum in four years. You are NOT required to take every course in the semester indicated. Many equivalent patterns are possible.

Notes: ENG 280 (Film Form and Sense) is a good course if students are interested in film. This class is also a pre-req for ENG 222 (Studies in World Cinema) and required for the Film Studies minor.

ENG 411 (Writing Workshop: Screenwriting) will be offered in the fall and ENG 280 is recommended beforehand, but not a prereq.

ENG does not recommend waiting until Sr. year to finish LSP courses.
