Prerequisite: ACCT 303 OR ACCT 602

## **BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION**

### **Curriculum Changes:**

### **New Course:**

BSAD 101 Business Leadership and the Liberal Arts

1 hour

Foundation principles and strategies to develop broadly educated business leaders through a liberal arts and sciences education. This course requires attendance at activities outside the scheduled course time. Prerequisite: Pre-accounting or pre-business administration major.

Prerequisite: ACCT 212 with grade of C or higher.

BSAD 350 Professional Seminar in Business 1 hour

Prerequisite: BSAD major.

BSAD 352 Production/Operations Management 3 hours

Prerequisites: BSAD, Accounting, or Computer Science major AND junior or senior standing AND ACCT 212 AND BSAD 349.

BSAD 357 Information Systems Concepts 3 hours

Prerequisites: BSAD, Accounting, or Computer Science major AND junior or senior standing AND ACCT 212.

BSAD 360 Marketing Research 3 hours

Prerequisites: BSAD 325 AND BSAD or Accounting major.

BSAD 365 Consumer Behavior 3 hours

Prerequisites: BSAD 325 AND BSAD or Accounting major.

BSAD 387 Business Database Management Systems 3 hours

Prerequisites: BSAD 357 AND BSAD or Accounting major.

BSAD 400 Internship 3-15 hours

Prerequisite: BSAD or Accounting major.

BSAD 406 Corporation Finance 3 hours

Prerequisites: BSAD 329 AND BSAD or Accounting major.

BSAD 414 Integrated Marketing Communication 3 hours

Prerequisites: BSAD 325 AND BSAD or Accounting major.

BSAD 415 Entrepreneurship 3 hours

Prerequisites: BSAD 325, BSAD 329, BSAD 349 AND BSAD or Accounting major.

BSAD 420 Investments 3 hours

Prerequisites: BSAD 406 AND BSAD or Accounting major.

BSAD 421 Retailing and Sales 3 hours

Prerequisites: BSAD 325 AND BSAD or Accounting major.

BSAD 423 Analysis and Design of Business Systems 3 hours

Prerequisites: BSAD 357 AND BSAD or Accounting major. Students may NOT use both BSAD 423 and CS 360 to satisfy business/accounting degree requirements. If both courses are completed, three hours will be counted as elective credit.

BSAD 433 Government Regulation of Business 3 hours

Prerequisite: BSAD 234 AND BSAD or Accounting major.

BSAD 439 Human Resource Management 3 hours

Prerequisite: BSAD 349 AND BSAD or Accounting major.

BSAD 441 Seminar in Finance 3 hours

Prerequisite: BSAD 406 AND BSAD or Accounting major.

BSAD 443 Management Information Systems 3 hours

Prerequisites: BSAD 357 AND BSAD, Accounting or Computer Science major, AND junior or senior standing.

BSAD 444 Electronic Commerce 3 hours

Prerequisites: BSAD 357 AND BSAD or Accounting major.

BSAD 445 Marketing Management 3 hours

Prerequisites: Senior status, AND (BSAD or Accounting major), AND (BSAD 360 or BSAD 365) AND (concurrent enrollment in BSAD 360 and BSAD 365).

BSAD 447 Labor-Management Relations 3 hours

Prerequisites: BSAD 349 AND BSAD or Accounting major.

BSAD 448 Small Business Practicum 3 hours

Prerequisites: senior status AND approval of the SBDC faculty coordinator AND BSAD or Accounting major.

BSAD 451 International Business 3 hours

Prerequisites: BSAD 325, BSAD 329, BSAD 349 AND BSAD or Accounting major.

BSAD 459 Research 2 hours

Prerequisites: 3.0 cumulative grade point average AND approval of instructor and division head AND BSAD major.

BSAD 460 Business Policy 3 hours

Prerequisites: BSAD 325, BSAD 329, BSAD 349, BSAD 352 AND senior standing AND applied for graduation.

BSAD 534 Commercial Law 3 hours

Prerequisite: BSAD, Accounting, or Master of Accountancy major. May not be taken credit/no credit.

BSAD 542 Decision Support Systems 3 hours

Prerequisites: (BSAD 443 or ACCT 367) AND BSAD, Accounting, or Master of Accountancy major.

BSAD 555 Independent Studies 1-3 hours  
Prerequisites: Permission of instructor and head of division AND BSAD or Master of Accountancy major.
