Parking Your Car in the Right Lot

To avoid getting ticketed, make sure to buy a parking pass. If you don't have one for your car, drop by the Department of Public Safety during the day to get yours. DPS is located north of the Rec Center. Your green sticker entitles you to park in any of the Green Sticker Lots. This includes the lot behind Missouri Hall, with one big exception. The northern most row of parking in the lot is Red Sticker Parking and is reserved for faculty and staff. If you park there during the 8:00-5:00 time, you will get ticketed.

Exterior Door Propping

Remember that everyone needs to come in through the front door after 10:30 PM. This helps us keep everyone safe and ensures only those people who belong in MO Hall are here. You can register a guest at the night monitor entrance. If you let someone in through the back or side doors, you're putting everyone's safety in jeopardy.
