### Immunizations Requirements

- <u>Two</u> MMR vaccines This means two shots, one month apart. These can cost between \$65-75 in the United States.
- A meningitis vaccine (if you live on campus)

Remember that you MUST have proof of your immunizations when you arrive or will have to pay to get the immunizations again.

## Immunizations Requirements

- Take care of this as soon as possible.
- Make sure that you keep your receipts and records from your immunizations to submit to the Student Health Center.



#### WHY TB TESTING?

All international students must take a TB test upon arriving at Truman. A previous TB test will not be accepted, this includes any TB test from your home country. The cost is \$110. Students with Lewer insurance should have all or at least a portion of the expense covered. ISEP students will have to pay for their own test. We will make TB testing appointments for you. The test is required because:

- Missouri has some strict laws about TB
- Many countries don't treat all forms of TB
  - One Active TB case at Truman: \$378,588 (costs to student)
- One Active TB case at Truman: lost 2 semesters of coursework

#### TB TESTING - THE PROCESS

Blood test\* Negative; Positive; most likely no TB - No problem! latent TB You can get free treatment for TB in the Proof of TB United States with your International requires chest Student Health Insurance! x-ray

\*TB blood test MUST be taken at Truman upon arrival.

Previous TB test results will NOT be acceptable,
including results from your home country.

\*Test fee is covered by insurance for most students.

ISEP students must pay for the test due to their specific insurance coverage.

Latent TB requires medication – FREE!
