



## **University Conduct Board Student Member Application**

### **Philosophy and Purpose**

The University Conduct Board hears cases of alleged misconduct to determine whether a student or student organization's behavior violates the Student Conduct Code, and if a violation is found, the imposition of sanctions. The board is comprised of faculty, staff, and student members.

#### **Qualifications for University Conduct Board Student Members**

- Applicants are expected to be in good academic and conduct standing.
- Applicants will commit to serving on the University Conduct Board for two years with term ending Dec. 31, 2018.
- Applicants must demonstrate a strong sense of social justice and an interest in serving the Truman State University community.
- Applicants must have strong personal integrity and uphold the confidentiality of the information/identity of individuals involved in conduct complaints.

#### Responsibilities for University Conduct Board Student Members

- Student members must attend all Conduct Board training sessions.
- Responsibilities during hearings include: reviewing all material carefully and listen to each witness fully, asking questions of witnesses as needed, engaging in meaningful discussions of the complaints and determine if the student/student organization is responsible for the behavior and if the behavior is a violation of the Student Conduct Code, recommending appropriate, creative, educationally based sanctions as needed.
- Student members will participate in planning meetings with the Office of Citizenship and Community Standards.
- Student members are expected to participate in educational outreach activities on a regular basis, including presentations to various student organizations.
- Student members will assist in the review and evaluation of written conduct sanction assignments each semester.
