Midwest Student Exchange Program (MSEP)**	Automatically awarded to admitted students from Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Minnesota, Michigan, Nebraska, North Dakota or Wisconsin who do not qualify for the Non-Resident Tuition Scholarship.	Reduces out-of-state tuition to 150% of the in-state tuition rate. Award value determined annually. MSEP award amount for the 2014-2015 academic year is \$2,584.
