Private scholarship funds and any supporting documentation should be sent to the Financial Aid Office for processing and scheduled disbursement. Truman will apply scholarship awards of \$1,000 or greater equally to Fall and Spring semester charges unless otherwise indicated by the accompanying scholarship criteria. Some scholarships are restricted (meaning the donor has designated a specific use such as tuition only). Others are more flexible and can be used for educational expenses such as room and board, books and supplies, and miscellaneous so any excess is allowed to be refunded.

Truman academic scholarships are primarily for tuition but can also be applied to on-campus room and board charges. If a restricted scholarship is submitted, we will make every effort to make use of it (ex: if a private scholarship is restricted to tuition, then Truman scholarships will be shifted, to the extent possible, to other approved charges). Truman scholarships are not refundable for off-campus expenses, so any excess is returned to the Truman scholarship fund for the current semester.
