The GSQ asks questions related to student satisfaction, campus involvement, and time spent on certain activities.

*From whom are the results available?*

Assessment and Testing Office, Violette Hall 1130.

*To whom are the results regularly distributed?*

University, School, and Discipline means and frequencies are sent to the Academic Deans and respective Department Chairs. University averages and frequencies are sent to the President, Provost, Deans, Assessment Committee, and selected administrators. University-wide results are published in this *Almanac*.

### **SUMMARY OF RESPONSES**

The Graduating Student Questionnaire (GSQ) is an online web-based survey administered by the Assessment & Testing Office and is completed by seniors as part of the graduation clearance process coordinated by the Registrar's Office each semester.

The questionnaire consists of questions focusing on students' future plans; satisfaction of services and facilities, experiences with faculty, impression of major and liberal arts courses, the major overall, and opportunities for interaction with others; the adequacy of major preparation and education and experiences; the amount of time spent in various activities; and some basic demographic information.

By looking at the means and frequencies of the responses, the university can identify areas of strength to build upon and possible areas of weakness to direct attention to. Means and frequencies from the fiscal year 2017 GSQ follow which identify a variety of areas with strengths and weaknesses.

**Adequacy of LSP, majors, and co-curriculum education and experiences . . .** (measured by means using the scale of 4=very adequate, 3=adequate, 2=inadequate, & 1=very inadequate)

### Strengths

In general students felt adequately to very adequately prepared in their majors with respect to: Attitude of believing that learning is a life-long process – 3.58; Ability to think critically – 3.56; Knowledge of subject matter – 3.52; Understanding multiple perspectives – 3.51; Ability to find information, interpret and apply findings – 3.51; Ability to apply knowledge in defining problems and solving them – 3.47; and Knowledge of modes of inquiry or processes – 3.42. Students felt adequately prepared with respect to the LSP in several areas especially in Writing Enhanced Courses: Using writing as a mode of learning – 3.29; Growing socially and personally from co-curricular experiences – 3.25; JINS: Integrating approaches or methods from two or more disciplines – 3.25; Physical Science: Experiencing scientific research in a laboratory setting – 3.13; Growing intellectually from co-curricular experiences – 3.12; Intercultural: Appreciating cultural diversity through studying one's own or other's societies – 3.10.

### Weaknesses

Freshman Program: Developing study and time management skills – 2.73; Personal Well-being: Understanding your mental and physical health needs – 2.87; Growing intellectually from on-campus residential experiences – 2.90; Elementary Functions: Developing basic skills in algebra – 2.93; Mathematics: Using math to study assumptions critically, reason logically, and arrive at sound conclusions – 2.95; Aesthetic-Fine Arts: Responding or reacting to an artistic creation – 2.97; and Philosophy and Religion: Interpreting and critically evaluating ethical and political issues and practices – 2.99.

Studying – 26.0% spent 11-15 hours per week, 22.0% spent 16-20 hours per week, 12.1% spent 21-25 hours per week, and 14.7% spent 26 or more hours per week; 93.1% often or very often Found their major courses challenging; 88.2% Felt they knew 2 or more faculty well enough to obtain a letter of recommendation; 88.2% often or very often Applied the knowledge and skills gained in one discipline to learning in other disciplines; 84.6% often or very often Discussed issues of social, cultural, or academic significance with others outside of class; 83.0% often or very often Discussed topics with students whose opinions/values differed; 79.6% often or very often reported Term papers, reports, or major writing assignments were required in their courses; 78.3% often or very often Participated in a co-curricular activity; 77.8% often or very often Communicated with a faculty member out of class; 73.4% often or very often Completed reading assignments in day-to-day preparation for class; 92.8% never or only a few times observed discrimination related to Individuals with disabilities on campus; 88.0% never or only a few times observed discrimination related to Sexual orientation; 87.3% never or only a few times observed discrimination related to Race on campus; 86.6% never or only a few times

observed discrimination related to Gender on campus; 98.6% Used computers weekly; 98.3% Socialized with friends weekly; 90.0% Spent time on research projects weekly; 80.6% spent time Watching television; 75.6% spent time on Other major activities weekly; 70.7% spent time Reading beyond course assignments weekly; 67.0% spent time on Academic organizations weekly; 66.3% spent time Working on campus weekly; and 84.6% are Involved in one or more co-curricular activities while 30.4% are involved in 3 or more activities.

Studying – 25.2% spent less than 10 hours per week studying; 29.3% do not spend time Reading beyond their course assignments; 71.9% never or seldom Used the writing center, language lab, computer labs, or tutorial services; 50.8% never or seldom Attended cultural events; 40.3% never or seldom Used library resources to gather research materials and information; 37.2% never or seldom Applied knowledge and skills gained in on-campus work to the classroom; 36.6% never or seldom found LSP courses challenging; 35.2% never or seldom Applied knowledge and skills gained in the classroom to on-campus work; 33.6% never or seldom Asked other students for advice/criticism on papers, projects, etc.; 32.8% never or seldom Applied knowledge and skills gained in co-curricular activities to the classroom; 32.2 never or seldom Applied knowledge and skills gained in the classroom to co-curricular activities; 29.4% never or seldom Interacted with people from other cultures; 26.5% never or seldom Completed reading assignments in day-to-day preparation for class; 22.2% never or seldom Communicated with a faculty member out of class; 21.8% never or seldom Participated in a co-curricular activity and 15.4% are not Involved in any co-curricular activity; 13.4% observed some or lot of Gender discrimination; 12.7% observed some or a lot of Race discrimination; 11.9% observed some or a lot of Sexual orientation discrimination on campus; and 7.2% observed some or a lot of Individual with disabilities discrimination; 80.6% Watch television weekly; and Participation: percentage of students not Spending time with Student Government Organization (90.1%); at Residence Hall activities/programs (82.3%); Performing in the arts (82.3%); Participating in intercollegiate sports (80.9%); Intramural Sports (68.1%); Religious Activities (67.2%); Employment off campus (64.4%); Greek Organizations (61.8%); or Creating art/music for personal interest (54.9%).

### **Other information worth noting . . .**

On a scale of 1 (low) to 4 (high), overall Truman students rated themselves fairly high with respect to several descriptors, particularly Working cooperative with a group – 3.60; Respecting the uniqueness and worth of each individual – 3.60; Understanding their own abilities, interests, and personality – 3.58; Learning on your own – 3.48; Persisting with difficult tasks – 3.45; and Leadership ability – 3.41. Managing their emotions (3.13) was the lowest rated descriptor.

Cost (41.3%), Academic Reputation (22.1%), Availability of Scholarship/Financial Aid (10.6%), and Type of Programs Available (8.0%) were the top primary reasons for students completing their degree at Truman; Cost (24.6%), Academic Reputation (22.4%), Size (12.2%), and Availability of Scholarship/Financial Aid (9.6) were the top secondary reasons.

84.3% would probably or definitely Choose Truman again if they started college over.

83.7% agree the Assessment program helps the university demonstrate the quality of its programs, 80.7% agree the Assessment program fosters curriculum improvement, and 78.7% of the students Know about and understand the purpose of the assessment program. 68.5% agree the Assessment Program helps to better understand personal strengths and weaknesses, but 31.6% do not agree.

96.4% of students agree that the University should survey student opinion.

80.0% completed the survey in 20 minutes or less.

### **High Impact Educational Experiences . . .**

89.2% of the students evaluated their entire educational experience at Truman as good or excellent. 85.8% indicated they were satisfied with the Quality of Instruction. Overall 69.6% evaluated their Quality of Academic Advising received as good or excellent and 30.4% evaluated it as fair or poor.

### **Second Major Related Responses . . .**

**Satisfaction of . . .** (measured by means or response percentages using the scale of 1=very dissatisfied, 2=dissatisfied, 3=satisfied, & 4=very satisfied)

Of the 1,283 survey respondents, 146 (11.4%) students indicated they had a second major and completed the related questions.

Experiences: Faculty enthusiasm for classes in the major – 3.42; Accessibility of instructors in the major – 3.41; Overall quality of instruction in the major – 3.24; Academic advising by faculty advisor in the major – 3.21

Services: Department office of the major – 3.30

Second major – 3.19; 78.3% felt major courses were often or very often challenging

#### Weaknesses

Experiences: 25.3% were dissatisfied with the availability of courses offered in the major; 14.6% were dissatisfied with academic advising by faculty advisor in the major; 10.7% were dissatisfied with the Overall quality of instruction in their major  
9.7% were dissatisfied with their second major

**Adequacy of major . . .** (measured by means or response percentages using the scale of 4=very adequate, 3=adequate, 2=inadequate, & 1=very inadequate)

#### Strengths

In general students felt adequately to very adequately prepared in their second major with respect to: Knowledge of Subject matter – 96.7%; Knowledge of Modes of inquiry or processes – 95.3%; Knowledge of Theories pertinent to the specialty – 95.2%; Knowledge of Issues and trends pertinent to the specialty – 92.0%; Ability to Think Critically – 96.7%; Ability to Apply knowledge in defining problems and solving them – 95.4%; Ability to Find information, interpret and apply findings – 94.7%; Attitude of Believing that learning is a life-long process – 96.0%; and Attitude of Understanding multiple perspectives – 95.4%.

#### Weaknesses

Knowledge of Scholars who are associated with the major – 19.4%
