#### **SUMMARY OF RESPONSES**

The Graduating Student Questionnaire (GSQ) is an online web-based survey administered by the Assessment & Testing Office and is completed as part of the graduation clearance process coordinated by the Registrar's Office each semester.

The questionnaire consists of questions focusing on students' future plans; satisfaction of services and facilities, experiences with faculty, impression of major and liberal arts courses, the major overall, and opportunities for interaction with others; the adequacy of major preparation and education and experiences; the amount of time spent in various activities; and some basic demographic information.

By looking at the means and frequencies of the responses, the university can identify areas of strength to build upon and possible areas of weakness to direct attention to. Means and frequencies from the fiscal year 2015 GSQ follow which identify a variety of areas with strengths and weaknesses.

### Strengths

Students felt adequately prepared with respect to the LSP in several areas especially in Growing socially and personally from co-curricular experiences – 3.28; Writing Enhanced Courses: Using writing as a mode of learning – 3.27; JINS: Integrating approaches or methods from two or more disciplines – 3.25; Growing intellectually from co-curricular experiences – 3.16; Intercultural: Appreciating cultural diversity through studying one's own or other's societies – 3.13; Physical Science: Experiencing scientific research in a laboratory setting – 3.11. In general students felt adequately to very adequately prepared in their majors with respect to: Ability to think critically – 3.57; Attitude of believing that learning is a life-long process – 3.56; Knowledge of subject matter – 3.50; Understanding multiple perspectives – 3.50; Ability to find information, interpret and apply findings – 3.49; and Ability to apply knowledge in defining problems and solving them – 3.45.

### Weaknesses

Freshman Program: Developing study and time management skills – 2.82; Elementary Functions: Developing basic skills in algebra – 2.89; Growing intellectually from on-campus residential experiences – 2.91; and Mathematics: Using math to study assumptions critically, reasoning logically, and arrive at sound conclusions – 2.92

### Weaknesses

Studying – 24.7% spent less than 10 hours per week studying; 23.9% do not spend time Reading beyond their course assignments; 69.2% never or seldom Used the writing center, language lab, computer labs, or tutorial services; 47.6% never or seldom Attended cultural events; 39.9% never or seldom Applied knowledge and skills gained in on-campus work to the classroom; 36.7% never or seldom Used library resources to gather research materials and information; 35.6% never or seldom Asked other students for advice/criticism on papers, projects, etc.; 34.8% never or seldom Applied knowledge and skills gained in the classroom to on-campus work; 32.8% never or seldom Interacted with people from other cultures; 32.7% never or seldom Applied knowledge and skills gained in co-curricular activities to the classroom; 28.0% never or seldom Completed reading assignments in day-to-day preparation for class; 20.0% never or seldom Participated in a co-curricular activity and 12.6% are not Involved in any co-curricular activity; 33.4% never or seldom found LSP courses challenging; 19.5% never or not very often were Term papers, reports, or major writing assignments required in their courses; 11.3% observed some or a lot of Sexual orientation discrimination on campus; 14.0% observed some or lot of Gender discrimination; 10.7% observed some or a lot of Race discrimination; and 7.0% observed some or a lot of Individual with disabilities discrimination; 83.3% Watch television weekly; and Participation: percentage of students not spending time with Student Government Organization (89.5%); Participating in intercollegiate sports (81.8%); Residence Hall activities/programs (81.0%); Performing in the arts (80.3%); Intramural Sports (64.6%); Greek Organizations (62.5%); Employment off campus (62.2%); Religious Activities (61.9%); and Creating art/music for personal interest (55.8%).

### **Other information worth noting . . .**

On a scale of 1 (low) to 4 (high), overall Truman students rated themselves fairly high with respect to several descriptors, particularly Understanding their own abilities, interests, and personality – 3.62; Working cooperative with a group – 3.61; Respecting the uniqueness and worth of each individual – 3.59; Learning on your own – 3.49; Persisting with difficult tasks – 3.43; and Leadership ability – 3.42. Managing their emotions (3.22) was the lowest rated descriptor.

Cost (41.3%), Academic Reputation (23.7%), and Availability of Scholarship/Financial Aid (9.4%) are the top three primary reasons for students completing their degree at Truman; Cost (24.0%), Academic Reputation (22.1%), and Size (14.2%) were the top three secondary reasons.

84.1% would probably or definitely Choose Truman again if they started over.

82.8% agree the Assessment program helps the university demonstrate the quality of its programs, 80.3% of the students Know about and understand the purpose of the assessment program, and 80.0% agree the Assessment program fosters curriculum improvement. 68.0% agree the Assessment Program helps to better understand personal strengths and weaknesses, but 32.0% do not agree.

96.3% of students agree that the University should survey student opinion.

80.2% completed the survey in 20 minutes or less.

### **High Impact Educational Experiences . . .**

89.9% of the students evaluated their entire educational experience at Truman as good or excellent. 85.0% indicated they were satisfied with the Quality of Instruction. Overall 68.9% evaluated their Quality of Academic Advising received as good or excellent and 31.1% evaluated it as fair or poor.

## **Second Major Related Responses . . .**

Of the 1,313 survey respondents, 154 (11.7%) students indicated they had a second major and completed the related questions.

10.5% are dissatisfied with their second major

Knowledge of Subject matter – 97.2%; Knowledge of Modes of inquiry or processes – 93.8%;

Knowledge of Theories pertinent to the specialty – 91.6%; and Knowledge of Issues and trends pertinent to the specialty – 88.2%

Knowledge of Scholars who are associated with the major – 24.1%; Issues and trends pertinent to your specialty – 11.9%
