Information Technology Services

ITS provides a wide variety of technology support and services to students, faculty and staff. Services include local network and Internet access, email, web site development, audiovisual and computer equipment checkout and support, Help Desk services, computer labs, assistance during move-in, and telephone and voice mail services.

Computers Available to Students

There are approximately 850 networked computers available for student use in general purpose and specialty labs and classrooms. These computers provide access to various software applications for completing assigned coursework. There are open-access computer labs in Violette Hall and Pickler Memorial Library. Students may checkout laptop computers from the Media Services office. Library-use laptops are also available at the Library circulation desk. In addition, all residence halls have access to a computer lab or kiosk systems

for student use (see your hall desk for availability).



Computer-equipped group study rooms are available for reservation at the Pickler Memorial Library 312 computer lab. These rooms are for study groups of three or more students that need computers for their group work.

Residence Hall Network Access

All residence hall rooms have high-speed network connections for each student in the room. This provides access to email, the Internet and network resources such as network drive space and personal web page space. Students need to provide their own network-equipped computer (with Windows XP, Mac OS X, or Linux/Unix) and a 25' CAT-5 patch cable. For more, visit http://its.truman.edu/resnet.



Wireless Network Access

Truman provides 802.11b/g wireless computer network coverage over the entire campus. This enables students to access the wireless network from any campus location—including their residence hall room. TruView Campus Portal

Using your Truman username and password you can access TruView from any Internet connection by going to the following site: http://truview.truman.edu. TruView provides access to University news, email, a personal calendar, and discussion groups. In addition, you may view your class schedule, view your grade reports, and register for classes.

Student Printing

The open-access computer labs in Violette Hall (VH2000) and Pickler Memorial Library (PL312) have access to monochrome and color laser printers. You begin each school year with \$25.00 in your printing account. Each semester that you are enrolled, \$25.00 is added to your account. Monochrome printing costs \$0.10 per page and color printing is \$0.50 per page. Each residence hall also has access to a computer lab or Hall Desk with a monochrome laser printer. Computer Security

To help us maintain security of the campus network, we utilize Cisco Clean Access. This will require students to install any vendor-provided security updates (such as Windows Critical Updates) and always run antivirus software that includes a current subscription for updates. Once on campus, Clean Access may require students to update their computers in order to connect to the campus network. Windows XP SP2 and all Windows critical updates will be required for Windows-based computers. The campus network will not support Windows ME, 98, 2000 or earlier versions.

Free Antivirus Software

ITS recommends that all students use the Truman-provided antivirus software that is available from the ITS web site. Updates and Help Desk support are provided by ITS free-of-charge. To download the software, visit http://its.truman.edu/resnet
