**SUMMARY OF RESPONSES** 

The Graduating Student Questionnaire (GSQ) is an online web-based survey administered by the Assessment & Testing Office and is completed by seniors as part of the graduation clearance process coordinated by the Registrar's Office each semester.

The questionnaire consists of questions focusing on students' future plans; satisfaction of services and facilities, experiences with faculty, impression of major and liberal arts courses, the major overall, and opportunities for interaction with others; the adequacy of major preparation and education and experiences; the amount of time spent in various activities; and some basic demographic information.

By looking at the means and frequencies of the responses, the university can identify areas of strength to build upon and possible areas of weakness to direct attention to. Means and frequencies from the fiscal year 2016 GSQ follow which identify a variety of areas with strengths and weaknesses.

#### Other information worth noting . . .

On a scale of 1 (low) to 4 (high), overall Truman students rated themselves fairly high with respect to several descriptors, particularly Working cooperative with a group -3.63; Understanding their own abilities, interests, and personality -3.60; Respecting the uniqueness and worth of each individual -3.59; Learning on your own -3.50; Persisting with difficult tasks -3.42; and Leadership ability -3.42. Managing their emotions (3.19) was the lowest rated descriptor.

Cost (43.1%), Academic Reputation (24.6%), Type of Programs Available (8.3%), and Availability of Scholarship/Financial Aid (8.2%) were the top primary reasons for students completing their degree at Truman; Academic Reputation (26.6%), Cost (23.0%), Size (12.0%), and Availability of Scholarship/Financial Aid (9.6) were the top secondary reasons.

83.8% would probably or definitely Choose Truman again if they started over.

83.7% agree the Assessment program helps the university demonstrate the quality of its programs, 80.0% of the students Know about and understand the purpose of the assessment program, and 79.0% agree the Assessment program fosters curriculum improvement. 68.1% agree the Assessment Program helps to better understand personal strengths and weaknesses, but 31.9% do not agree.

95.9% of students agree that the University should survey student opinion.

79.5% completed the survey in 20 minutes or less.

#### **High Impact Educational Experiences...**

89.9% of the students evaluated their entire educational experience at Truman as good or excellent. 85.3% indicated they were satisfied with the Quality of Instruction. Overall 70.3% evaluated their Quality of Academic Advising received as good or excellent and 29.7% evaluated it as fair or poor.


