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*Most Spanish majors study abroad. In this case, the student could choose to participate in a faculty-led summer program to Spain or Costa Rica after the freshman or sophomore year for 6 hours of major credit and 6 hours of elective credit OR s/he could study abroad for an entire semester and transfer 9 hours of credit into the major. The remaining credit earned could be applied to a second major, a minor, or used as general elective credit.*

The Dialogues curriculum requires a certain number of courses/credit hours in the following Perspectives: Social, Arts and Humanities, STEM, Communications, and Statistics. The exact number of courses a student will be required to take during their undergraduate career varies individually according to the credit transferred in.
