SPRING - Semester 4

- If Option 2: Sociology -- SOAN 450: Topics in Sociology OR SOAN 452: Integrated Topics in Society and Environment OR other Level 4 course (1-4 cr)
- **Level 4 SOAN course** (1-3 cr) (*if needed*)
- Bachelor of Science Requirement course, Foreign Language (BA), OR Elective

NOTES:

- (*) Students in the Sociology/Anthropology choose either "**Option 1: Anthropology**" or "**Option 2: Sociology**." Each Option has **4 levels** of courses and a **capstone** requirement. See academic program page in the University Catalog for more information.
- (**) The content of **STAT 190: Basic Statistics** is an important prerequisite/co-requisite for SOAN 381. Students who haven't completed a basic statistics course should plan to take one by Semester 3.
- Any Minor can pair with the SOAN major. Suggested minors to pair with this 2-year plan are:
 - History,
 - Psychology,
 - Biology, or
 - Political Science
- WE = Writing Enhanced course
