



Counseling (MA), School Counseling Track

This course sequence applies for full-time students beginning in Fall 2024/Spring 2025 and may be adjusted. Students admitted at other times or at other paces may experience variations.

*The Counseling (MA) program offers **fall and spring entry terms**. A total of **60 credit hours** is required to graduate from the program, divided into "**Core Requirements**" (48 cr), "**Professional Practice Requirements**" (3 cr), and the "**Practicum and Internship**" requirements (9 cr). Fall and Spring COUN courses are offered as **semester-long courses**. There are no block-length courses. Summer COUN courses are typically 10 weeks.*

NOTES:

- Full-semester courses are 16-weeks.
- (*) - Indicates courses that would be taken if students intends to enroll full-time.
- (+) - Many school districts do not offer sufficient clinical hours during the summer. When a school counseling student's internship is scheduled for summer, its replaced with COUN 661G Professional Practice in Schools. The replaced internship then falls in the seventh semester instead.
- (^) - Counseling students must complete **COUN 653G: Practicum in School Counseling** **AND** a combination of internship courses (to total 6 credits). *Internship courses may be repeated for credit.* Internship course options include:
 - COUN 668G: Counseling Internships (3 cr)
 - COUN 680G: Internship Elementary Education (3 cr)
 - COUN 681G: Internship Secondary Education (3 cr)
 - COUN 683G: Internship in Clinical Mental Health (3 cr)
