BSAD 157 Information Technology
ACCT 211 Accounting for Business Operations
2. An overall cumulative GPA of 2.75
3. Submit a semester-by-semester planned class schedule that would fulfill graduation requirements.
4. Students should currently be enrolled in or have completed ACCT 212, BSAD 234, and ECON 200 or ECON 201.

## Business Administration - Bachelor's Degree

## Admission to the Business Administration Program:

Students planning to major in business administration must meet the following admission requirements before enrolling in upper division business courses:

1. Completion of 40 hours, including the following courses with a grade of C or better: ENG 190 Writing as Critical Thinking
