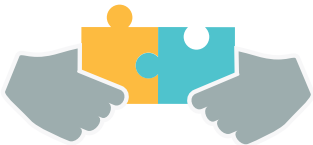

Master of Arts  
in Education



Students will get hands-on learning experiences at multiple levels within the classroom.

Truman's MAE has accreditation from Missouri Department of Elementary & Secondary Education (DESE) and Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP).



Students will complete an undergraduate degree in a discipline and then complete the MAE to learn how to teach their specialization area. The MAE takes at least one year to complete.
