

TAILGATE POLICIES



PARKING/COSTS

The campus parking lot used for tailgating will be Lot 26 (see map above) located on Stadium Drive, south of Stokes Stadium. Tailgating will be allowed in this lot beginning three hours before the football game and ending 15 minutes prior to kickoff. Tailgating is not allowed at any other time. \$10 per game (cash only and space limited) to park in the stadium lot. Stadium parking passes for the season starting in August will be \$30.00 or \$20.00 with the purchase of either a Tru-Pass or Football Season ticket. Access the lot by entering from the west off of Franklin Street up Stadium Drive (one way only).

POSSESSION and CONSUMPTION of ALCOHOL

- No one under 21 is permitted to consume or possess an alcoholic beverage. Anyone possessing and/or consuming an alcoholic beverage shall possess valid photo identification establishing that he/she is 21 years of age or older and comply with a request to show such identification when requested by law enforcement, game security personnel, or a University official.
- Designated tailgate lot will open three hours prior to kickoff; tailgate activities must end 15 minutes prior to kick-off.

- Designated lot for tailgating will be marked with signage and spaces will be available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- All alcoholic beverages must remain in designated areas. Individuals who take alcoholic beverages outside the designated area and minors in possession of alcohol are subject to arrest and prosecution.
- Only beer and wine will be allowed and must be in cans or cups. No glass containers are permitted. Hard liquor and hard liquor products are prohibited. Kegs are not allowed.
- Household furniture intended for interior use such as couches, chairs, and coffee tables are prohibited in parking lots and tailgate areas.
- Drinking games and other activities that promote excess drinking are prohibited.
- The sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.
- Motor vehicles may occupy one parking space only. Tailgate activities may not occupy a parking space. Parking spaces may not be reserved or saved for others. Individuals who want to tailgate adjacent to one another must arrive and enter parking lots at the same time. Tailgating activities are to be restricted to your vehicle space.
- Tents, tables and other tailgating items cannot obstruct travel lanes.
- Each individual is responsible for making sure that the tailgating area and grounds are maintained in a clean and orderly manner. No trash or recyclable items are to be discarded anywhere except in trash and recycling containers placed in proper bins supplied by the University in the tailgating areas.
- No open flames. Charcoal grills will be allowed; however, embers/ashes shall not be disposed of in/on University property or containers, including in University dumpsters.
- If any food is to be catered, it must be provided through Sodexo, (660) 785-4198.
- Failure to comply with these policies may result in criminal charges, loss of tailgating privileges and ¥or student disciplinary charges.
