


## Freshman Automatic Scholarships

## Students are notified of automatic awards upon acceptance to the University.

Midwest Student Exchange Program	\$3,372 (if student does not qualify for TruMerit Scholarship and lives in IL, IN, KS, MN, NE, ND, OH, or WI)
Bulldog Legacy	\$1,000 per year (Missouri Residents) or \$2,000 per year (Non-Missouri Residents)
A+ Recognition	\$500 per year, must be conferred on final high school transcript
Non-Resident Tuition Waiver	Tuition waiver covering the out-of-state portion of tuition for students whose: 1) non-custodial parent is a Missouri resident or 2) for students who are spouses, dependent children, or are a current/recent member of a branch of Military.
TruMerit	Various amounts (see charts below)

The Non-Resident portion of tuition is \$7,360. Award packages for Non-Missouri residents are adjusted appropriately if the student becomes a Missouri resident. Out-of-State TruMerit, Non-Resident Tuition Waiver, Military Non-Resident Tuition Waiver, and MSEP are designed to assist with the out-of-state portion of tuition and cannot be combined. Students eligible for multiple awards designed to assist with the out-of-state portion of tuition will receive the award of the greatest value. If awarded a tuition waiver, other scholarships in their package will be updated to reflect consideration as an in-state student.

General John J. Pershing	Top candidates have exceptional academic and co-curricular accomplishments and are typically in the top 3% of their HS class with ACT or SAT scores in the top 3% nationally	Twelve awards annually. Covers tuition and average on- campus room and meal plan annually, plus a one-time \$4,000 study abroad stipend. Supersedes other Truman- funded awards
Harry S. Truman Leadership	Missouri residents who demonstrate impactful classroom, school and/or community leadership. Designed to invest in the development of tomorrow's leaders, recognizing the value of diverse contributions in Truman's community	Limited number of \$10,000 per year awards granted annually that assist with tuition and on-campus room and meal plan costs, plus a 4-year leadership development program. Supersedes other Truman-funded awards
Missouri Boys State & Missouri Girls State	Missouri residents who completed Missouri Boys State or Missouri Girls State, considered competitively	Twenty \$1,000 per year Boys State and twenty \$1,000 per year Girls State awards granted annually
International Baccalaureate (IB)	IB Diploma Candidate status must be noted on HS transcript for competitive consideration. Completion must be verified on official final transcript	Fifteen \$2,000 per year awards granted annually
Live, Learn, Lead	Record of and demonstrated interest in community leadership and betterment. Designed to invest in future campus community leaders	One hundred \$1,500 awards granted annually to assist with on-campus room and meal plans
President's Leadership	Significant record of leadership in classroom, community and/or co-curricular activities while maintaining exemplary academic achievement	Limited number of awards in varying amounts
President's Honorary	Record of exceptional academic achievement	Limited number of awards in varying amounts

Competitive scholarship review begins in December. Students are encouraged to apply by **December 1** to ensure fullest consideration for competitive awards. All admitted students are considered for competitive scholarship review starting on December 1.
