TRANSFERRING CREDIT

Most students report a majority of their college coursework transferring to Truman. To see what that really means for

you, visit willittransfer.truman.edu to see how your credits will transfer to Truman! Transfer students wishing to graduate in a baccalaureate degree program must earn a minimum of 45 hours of credit in Truman coursework, with the last 28 taken in residence. A minimum of 15 hours of required major coursework must be completed at Truman.

Students who have completed an Associate of arts (AA) or Associate of Arts in Teaching (AAT) in the state of Missouri will also fulfill the core general education requirements at Truman.*

*Students who have completed an Associate of Science (AS) will have their credits evaluated on a course-by-course basis
